### CITY FACTS

- **The Old Town of Klaipeda city** with its tight network of streets, enchanting interior courtyards, German Fachwerk buildings and, above all, the famous Drama Theatre and Square, has remained virtually unchanged since the 17th century.
- **Aquarium and Dolphinarium:** Built in an old fort, the aquarium houses penguins, seals and sea lions. The dolphinarium boasts five bottle nosed Black Sea dolphins. Synchronized swimming shows and concerts are held in the evenings.
- **History Museum of Lithuania Minor:** One of the most complete and well-designed museums in Lithuania and one of the best introductions to early Lithuanian history. From the Mesolithic through the modern age, archaeological finds such as Roman Imperial coins and detailed maps of Prussia tell of lively trading routes connecting Lithuania Minor to Europe and beyond.
- **Clock and Watch Museum:** Read about the history of timepieces from primitive calendars through millisecond-accurate nuclear clocks. The summer garden, which houses a complex sundial is said to be the best place to hear the post office carillon bells ring at noon on weekends.
